Minimum qualifications are:

- At least 18 years old and able to provide documentation to work in the USA
- Completion of 2 years of college coursework, preferably in science or education or equivalent experience
- At least 6 months working with children in an informal or formal setting
- Former Houston Zoo Crew teen program participants are eligible without completing 2 years of college
- Able to attend required 2-day training
- Able to work at least 5 weeks during the summer from June 4- August 18, 2017 and at least two weekdays during year-round school break camps (Tentative dates are: November 19, 20 and 21; December 20,21, 26,27 and 28, January 2,3 and 4)
- Pass a background check and drug screen testing
- Must be able to walk or stand outdoors 65% of the time in all weather conditions.
